Mumm Reims, 1998 Gloria-Ferrer Late Disgorged Carneros Cuvée, J Vineyards & Winery's 1998 RRV Brut Late Disgorged - tête de cuvée, Veuve-Clicquot, etc.**), we are delighted to include the **1999 Bollinger Grande Année**. Members and friends will also be introduced to two superb Rosé Champagnes--- **Champagne Gonet-Médeville Premier Cru Rosé** and the newest addition to the Bollinger family, the first in 30 years, **Champagne Bollinger Rosé**.

Our tasting will be followed by a multi-course Champagne dinner and Wine Tasting Olympics. A flight of high-end mystery red wines from around the world will accompany the main course of beef filet "marchand de vin". The person best able to identify the varietal and place of origin of each wine will win a prize.

Following the dinner, **A. Edmond Audry's "Memorial Fine" Cognac** will be poured upstairs. This Cognac, the best one you probably have never heard of, is made with large stocks of older base spirits. It is difficult to find in the U.S. but worth the extra legwork in locating. We are pleased to be able to bring another special treat to attendees.

As our members who routinely purchase premium French Champagnes know, prices are at all-time highs due to a limited supply of the finest, the tremendous consumer demand from China and India, and the beleaguered dollar. Some fetch over \$200/bottle. This outstanding event is being underwritten by the Vintners Club, and is therefore offered at: **\$205/member, \$305/non-member. Price includes 20% gratuity, 8.75% tax and corkage charges.**
